

TRAVEL INFORMATION

International Visitors

Step 1: Arrival in Ghana – Fly into Accra International Airport in the capital city, Accra.

Step 2: Transit to Kumasi – The most efficient alternative is taking a short **45-to-50-minute domestic flight** from Accra (ACC) to Kumasi International Airport (KMS) via local carriers like PassionAir or Africa World Airlines (AWA).

Step 3: Airport to Campus – Upon landing at Kumasi Airport, take an airport taxi or use ride-hailing apps (preferably Uber or Bolt) directly to the **KNUST School of Business Postgraduate Centre**.

* There are no direct long-haul international flights straight into Kumasi.

Local / Inter-City Visitors

If you are travelling by road from other regions in Ghana, your primary aim is to head towards Kumasi and request a drop-off at **Tech Junction**.

By Air: Fly from Accra or Tamale into Kumasi Airport, then take a taxi to campus.

By Bus: Reliable long-distance coach services like VIP Jeoun or STC run frequent daily schedules from major cities.

- If coming from Accra, the road trip takes roughly **5 to 7 hours** depending on traffic.
- Ask the bus conductor to alight at the **Tech Junction** stop so you do not have to travel all the way to the central Kumasi terminal.

Navigating from Tech Junction to the Postgraduate Centre

Once you reach the perimeter of the university, commercial transport restrictions apply inside the campus gates for security reasons.

Ride-Hailing Apps: Uber, Bolt and Yango operate extensively in Kumasi. Set your exact destination to "**KNUST School of Business Postgraduate Block**". They are permitted to drive directly onto campus.

- **Embossed Campus Taxis:** Regular city commercial vehicles (trotros) cannot enter the main campus gates. You must pick up officially branded **campus taxis with yellow stickers** from the Tech Junction rank. Ask the driver for the "School of Business New Graduate Block".
- **Campus Shuttles:** Internal shuttle buses run from Bomso Gate through the campus ring road. You can drop off at the **Business School Bus Stop**
